REGULATIONS
on the Prize Pool
of the International Multisport Tournament
“GAMES OF THE FUTURE”

to be held for a period
from December 14, 2025, to December 23, 2025,
in Abu Dhabi, UAE

Preamble

The terms defined in these Regulations on the Prize Pool for the International Multisport Tournament “GAMES OF THE FUTURE” (“the Regulations on the Prize Pool”) apply to the GotF 2025 Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and any other relevant documents issued by PI.

Terms defined herein retain their meaning regardless of capitalization.

Terms in the Regulations on the Prize Pool may be used in either singular or plural form without altering their meaning.

References to individuals in the Regulations on the Prize Pool apply to all genders.

Article 1. General Provisions

1. In accordance with paragraph 4 of Chapter 8 of the Rules and Regulations of the International Multisport Competition to be held in Abu Dhabi, UAE, from December 14, 2025, to December 23, 2025, titled “GAMES OF THE FUTURE” (“the GotF 2025 Rules and Regulations”, “the GotF 2025”, respectively):
 - 1.1. The total prize pool for the GotF 2025 is established at **\$4,175,000 (Four million one hundred seventy-five thousand) US dollars.**
 - 1.2. The GotF 2025 prize pool shall be distributed among the various sports events (sports disciplines) and types of competition activities (jointly - “the Competition Disciplines”, and separately – “the Competition Discipline”) **as follows:**

Battle Royale	\$700 000 (Seven hundred thousand) US dollars
MOBA PC	\$175 000 (One hundred seventy-five thousand) US dollars
MOBA Mobile	\$900 000 (Nine hundred thousand) US dollars
Battle of Robots	\$400 000 (Four hundred thousand) US dollars
Drone Racing	\$250 000 (Two hundred fifty thousand) US dollars
Phygital Dancing	\$50 000 (Fifty thousand) US dollars
VR-game	\$50 000 (Fifty thousand) US dollars

2. The prize pool shall be paid out according to the results of the competitions in each Competition Discipline held as part of the GotF 2025. The payout will be based on the final score sheet for each competition in a separate Competition Discipline of the GotF 2025, which contains information on the final standing ranks and the amount specified in the Regulations on the Prize Pool, and is subject to any disciplinary sanctions imposed on participants pursuant to the Regulatory Documents. All places stated by the Regulations are recognized as prize-winning positions.

Article 2. Prize Pool Distribution for Phygital Football

1. The prize pool for the Phygital Football Competition Discipline shall be distributed based on the teams' (athletes') rankings in the following order:
 - 1 place– \$210 000 (Two hundred ten thousand) US dollars;
 - 2 place – \$96 000 (Ninety-six thousand) US dollars;
 - 3 place – \$72 000 (Seventy-two thousand) US dollars;
 - 4 place – \$42 000 (Forty-two thousand) US dollars;
 - 5th to 8th place –\$21 000 (Twenty-one thousand) US dollars;
 - 9th to 12th place –\$15 000 (Fifteen thousand) US dollars;
 - 13th to 16th place –\$9 000 (Nine thousand) US dollars.

Article 3. Prize Pool Distribution for Phygital Basketball

1. The prize pool for the Phygital Basketball Competition Discipline shall be distributed based on the teams' (athletes') rankings in the following order:
 - 1 place– \$140 000 (One hundred forty thousand) US dollars;
 - 2 place – \$64 000 (Sixty-four thousand) US dollars;
 - 3 place – \$48 000 (Forty-eight thousand) US dollars;
 - 4 place – \$28 000 (Twenty-eight thousand) US dollars;
 - 5th to 8th place –\$14 000 (Fourteen thousand) US dollars;
 - 9th to 12th place –\$10 000 (Ten thousand) US dollars;
 - 13th to 16th place –\$6 000 (Six thousand) US dollars.

Article 4. Prize Pool Distribution for Phygital Fighting. MMA

1. The prize pool for the Phygital Fighting. MMA Competition Discipline shall be distributed based on the teams' (athletes') rankings in the following order:
 - 1 place– \$100 000 (One hundred thousand) US dollars;
 - 2 place – \$80 000 (Eighty thousand) US dollars;
 - 3 place – \$70 000 (Seventy thousand) US dollars;
 - 4 place – \$60 000 (Sixty thousand) US dollars;
 - 5 place – \$55 000 (Fifty-five thousand) US dollars;
 - 6 place – \$50 000 (Fifty thousand) US dollars;
 - 7 place – \$45 000 (Forty-five thousand) US dollars;
 - 8 place – \$40 000 (Forty thousand) US dollars.

Article 5. Prize Pool Distribution for Phygital Shooter. 5-on-5

1. The prize pool for the Phygital Shooter. 5-on-5 Competition Discipline shall be distributed based on the teams' (athletes') rankings in the following order:
 - 1 place– \$52 500 (Fifty-two thousand five hundred) US dollars;
 - 2 place – \$30 000 (Thirty thousand) US dollars;

- 3 place – \$22 500 (Twenty-two thousand five hundred) US dollars;
- 4 place – \$15 000 (Fifteen thousand) US dollars;
- 5th to 6th place – \$9 000 (Nine thousand) US dollars;
- 7th to 8th place – \$6 000 (Six thousand) US dollars.

Article 6. Prize Pool Distribution for Battle Royale

1. The prize pool for the Battle Royale Competition Discipline shall be distributed based on the teams' (athletes') rankings in the following order:
 - 1 place– \$70 000 (Seventy thousand) US dollars;
 - 2 place – \$65 000 (Sixty-five thousand) US dollars;
 - 3 place – \$55 000 (Fifty-five thousand) US dollars;
 - 4 place – \$45 000 (Forty-five thousand) US dollars;
 - 5 place – \$40 000 (Forty thousand) US dollars;
 - 6 place – \$35 000 (Thirty-five thousand) US dollars;
 - 7 place – \$35 000 (Thirty-five thousand) US dollars;
 - 8 place – \$35 000 (Thirty-five thousand) US dollars;
 - 9 place – \$35 000 (Thirty-five thousand) US dollars;
 - 10 place – \$35 000 (Thirty-five thousand) US dollars;
 - 11 place – \$30 000 (Thirty thousand) US dollars;
 - 12 place – \$30 000 (Thirty thousand) US dollars;
 - 13 place – \$30 000 (Thirty thousand) US dollars;
 - 14 place – \$30 000 (Thirty thousand) US dollars;
 - 15 place – \$30 000 (Thirty thousand) US dollars;
 - 16 place – \$20 000 (Twenty thousand) US dollars;
 - 17 place – \$20 000 (Twenty thousand) US dollars;
 - 18 place – \$20 000 (Twenty thousand) US dollars;
 - 19 place – \$20 000 (Twenty thousand) US dollars;
 - 20 place – \$20 000 (Twenty thousand) US dollars.

Article 7. Prize Pool Distribution for MOBA PC

1. The prize pool for the MOBA PC Competition Discipline shall be distributed based on the teams' (athletes') rankings in the following order:
 - 1 place– \$61 250 (Sixty-one thousand two hundred fifty) US dollars;
 - 2 place – \$35 000 (Thirty-five thousand) US dollars;
 - 3 place – \$26 250 (Twenty-six thousand two hundred fifty) US dollars;
 - 4 place – \$17 500 (Seventeen thousand five hundred) US dollars;
 - 5th to 6th place –\$10 500 (Ten thousand five hundred) US dollars;
 - 7th to 8th place –\$7 000 (Seven thousand) US dollars.

Article 8. Prize Pool Distribution for MOBA Mobile

1. The prize pool for the MOBA Mobile Competition Discipline shall be distributed based on the teams' (athletes') rankings in the following order:
 - 1 place– \$315 000 (Three hundred fifteen thousand) US dollars;
 - 2 place – \$144 000 (One hundred forty-four thousand) US dollars;
 - 3 place – \$108 000 (One hundred eight thousand) US dollars;
 - 4 place – \$63 000 (Sixty-three thousand) US dollars;
 - 5th to 8th place –\$31 500 (Thirty-one thousand five hundred) US dollars;
 - 9th to 12th place –\$22 500 (Twenty-two thousand five hundred) US dollars;
 - 13th to 16th place –\$13 500 (Thirteen thousand five hundred) US dollars.

Article 9. Prize Pool Distribution for Battle of Robots

1. The prize pool for the Battle of Robots Competition Discipline shall be distributed based on the teams' (athletes') rankings in the following order:
 - 1 place– \$140 000 (One hundred forty thousand) US dollars;
 - 2 place – \$64 000 (Sixty-four thousand) US dollars;
 - 3 place – \$48 000 (Forty-eight thousand) US dollars;
 - 4 place – \$28 000 (Twenty-eight thousand) US dollars;
 - 5th to 8th place –\$14 000 (Fourteen thousand) US dollars;
 - 9th to 12th place –\$10 000 (Ten thousand) US dollars;
 - 13th to 16th place –\$6 000 (Six thousand) US dollars.

Article 10. Prize Pool Distribution for Drone Racing

1. The prize pool for the Drone Racing Competition Discipline shall be distributed based on the teams' (athletes') rankings in the following order:
 - 1 place– \$87 500 (Eighty-seven thousand five hundred) US dollars;
 - 2 place – \$40 000 (Forty thousand) US dollars;
 - 3 place – \$30 000 (Thirty thousand) US dollars;
 - 4 place – \$17 500 (Seventeen thousand five hundred) US dollars;
 - 5th to 8th place – \$8 750 (Eight thousand seven hundred fifty) US dollars;
 - 9th to 16th place –\$5 000 (Five thousand) US dollars.

Article 11. Prize Pool Distribution for Phygital Dancing

1. The prize pool distribution for the Phygital Dancing Competition Discipline shall be distributed based on the teams' (athletes') rankings in the following order:
 - 1 place– \$17 500 (Seventeen thousand five hundred) US dollars;
 - 2 place – \$8 000 (Eight thousand) US dollars;
 - 3 place – \$6 000 (Six thousand) US dollars;
 - 4 place – \$3 500 (Three thousand five hundred) US dollars;

- 5th to 8th place –\$1 750 (One thousand seven hundred fifty) US dollars;
- 9th to 16th place –\$1 000 (One thousand) US dollars.

Article 12. Prize Pool Distribution for VR-game

1. Establish the prize pool distribution for the VR-game Competition Discipline based on the teams' (athletes') rankings in the following order:
 - 1 place– \$17 500 (Seventeen thousand five hundred) US dollars;
 - 2 place – \$12 500 (Twelve thousand five hundred) US dollars;
 - 3 place – \$10 000 (Ten thousand) US dollars;
 - 4 place – \$6 000 (Six thousand) US dollars;
 - 5th place –\$2 500 (Two thousand five hundred) US dollars;
 - 6th place –\$1 500 (One thousand five hundred) US dollars.

Article 13. Prize Pool Payment Procedure

1. The prize pool payment is made by PI in accordance with the procedures outlined in the GotF 2025 Rules and Regulations and the Conditions for Participation in the GotF 2025.
2. The prize pool is paid in US dollars via non-cash transfer to the GotF 2025 participants' accounts provided by the participants for signing the application for participation in the GotF 2025, or to third parties designated by the GotF 2025 participants.

Article 14. Terms and Conditions for Prize Pool Payment

1. PI guarantees that the prize pool will be paid out either by its own means or through a third-party intermediary authorized by PI within 180 (One hundred eighty) calendar days from the date of approval of the GotF 2025 results. This is contingent upon the participant providing the necessary bank details for the full payment of the cash prize.

For clarification, if a Chief Panel of Judges or the WPC Disciplinary Committee decision changes the final standings, PI will adjust prize payments to reflect the updated results.

2. The payment can be made to the account of an individual or a legal entity, based on the GotF 2025 participant's status, or the details of a third party designated by the participant to receive the payment. In the event that an individual acting solely without a legal entity or Sports Club requests to receive payment through a third party, the individual shall be obligated to present a written consent from the third party confirming the third party's acceptance to receive the payment on behalf of the individual. If such consent is not presented by the individual, PI shall have the right to delay the payment until receiving the consent or the individual's personal requisites.
 - 2.1. In case the individual, the Sports Club (or any other legal entity) requests a change to the payment bank details, PI has the right to decline such a change for organizational reasons.
3. If the prize pool is paid out directly to the accounts of individuals (athletes who are members of a Sports Team or Sports Club), the prize money for the respective places shall be distributed equally among the recipient athletes.

If the prize pool is paid out to the legal entity's account or to another person as requested by the GotF 2025 participants, PI or the third party authorized by PI (intermediary) is not responsible for the subsequent (final) distribution of the prize pool directly among the athletes – members of the Sports Team/Sports Club/other legal entity. Accordingly, the Sports Club, legal entity, or the recipient of the prize pool, as requested by the GotF 2025 participants, shall be responsible for such distribution.

4. The prize pool payment date is the day when funds are debited from PI's current account or its authorized intermediary.

5. PI or the third party authorized by PI (intermediary) are not liable for partial or complete failure to fulfill the cash prize payment obligations in the event of force majeure or any other circumstances beyond their control, which they could not foresee or prevent such as: prohibitive (restrictive) measures of foreign states, prohibition of trade operations (including with individual countries), restriction of banking operations due to the adoption of international sanctions, earthquake, flood, fire, acts of state (municipal) authorities of a prohibitive nature (including the introduction of restrictive measures in connection with the threat of the spread of coronavirus infection, including in the form of a ban on holding any mass and other events, suspension/termination in due to such restrictions on the activities of state (municipal) bodies and organizations, the introduction of non-working days during the period of restrictive measures), the introduction of a state of war or emergency, strikes, rallies, mass popular unrest, etc.
 - 5.1. If the conditions outlined in paragraph 5 of this Article occur, the deadline for meeting the prize pool payment obligations is extended in relation to the duration of these circumstances and their effects.

Article 15. Tax and other Fees / Commissions

1. Prize pool payments are made by PI or its authorized intermediary after withholding all taxes for individuals, as required by the current legislation of the country of payment (or the country of intermediary). The payable sum may be deducted from the amount of the applicable taxes.
 - 1.1. Legal entities receiving the cash prize are responsible for paying any applicable taxes independently (at their own costs).
2. All prize pool amounts specified in the Regulations on the Prize Pool are indicated prior to the deduction of any taxes required by the current legislation of the country of payment.
 - 2.1. All recipients of the prize pool payments are responsible for paying any applicable taxes required by the country in which they receive the payment independently (at their own costs).
3. Any bank commissions or similar fees of the intermediary authorized by PI arising from the payment of the prize fund shall be borne by PI. PI shall not be responsible for paying any bank commissions or similar fees of credit institutions other than its authorized intermediary.

Article 16. Dispute Resolution Procedure

1. Any disputes, controversies, or claims in connection with the payment of a cash prize for participation in the GotF 2025 between the GotF 2025 participants, PI, a third party authorized by PI (intermediary), or any other persons mentioned in the Regulations on the Prize Pool, and/or with the participation of other persons who have agreed to be bound by the GotF 2025 Rules and Regulations (jointly - “the Parties”, and separately – “the Party”), shall be settled by the Parties through negotiations. For clarification, all matters affecting rankings, results or match outcomes are governed by the WPC Disciplinary Regulations.
2. If the Parties fail to reach a settlement through negotiations within 30 (Thirty) days from the date a dispute arises, any of the Parties may refer to and finally resolved by arbitration under the Arbitration Rules of the London Court of International Arbitration, which Rules are deemed to be incorporated by reference into this Article.

The number of arbitrators shall be three.

The seat, or legal place, of arbitration shall be the DIFC.

The language to be used in the arbitration shall be English.

The governing law of the arbitration agreement shall be the substantive laws of England and Wales.

Article 17. Final Provisions

1. The Regulations on the Prize Pool take effect once approved by PI. Revisions and additions also require PI's approval. Once approved, changes take effect immediately, unless PI decides otherwise. No further notification will be sent to the GotF 2025 participants unless stated.
2. Matters not governed by the Regulations on the Prize Pool will be resolved by PI in accordance with the GotF 2025 Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and the applicable laws.
3. If necessary, in the event of discrepancies between the Regulations on the Prize Pool, the GotF 2025 Rules and Regulations, the Regulatory Documents, and the applicable laws, the interpretation of the respective documents, as well as the final decision on overcoming the relevant contradictions, will be made by PI. This decision will be guided by legal precedent, statutory analogy, and the principles of good faith, reasonableness, and fairness.
